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Utah State Office of Rehabilitation: Transition

The Utah State Office of Rehabilitation provides transition services to eligible students with disabilities as they transition from school to adult life. Their goal is to provide students with a smooth transition, holistic team approach, and services that are necessary and reasonable to help prepare for, obtain, and maintain employment. These services may include:

- VR Counseling and Guidance
- Medical/Psychological Restoration
- IEP and 504 Planning
- Job Development and Placement
- Supported Employment
- Work Adjustment and Life Skills Training
- Employer Supports and Accommodations
- Assistive Technology
- Training and Education

The goal of Vocational Rehabilitation transition counselors is to provide the most appropriate counseling and guidance for successful transition from high school to adulthood, independence, and employment.
